ABOUT THE STAFF

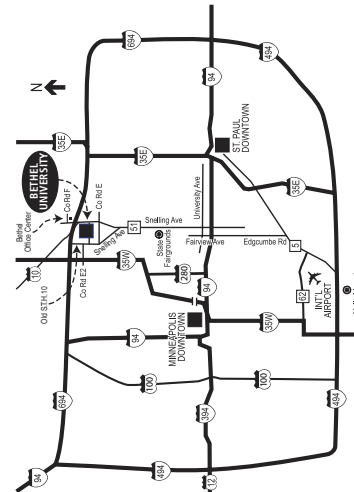
The GTCBS instructional staff will include the current Bethel University baseball coaching staff and players. Additional area high school coaches will assist as needed.
